## MDC Hosts 15th Annual Source to Sea Cleanup at Wethersfield Cove

For the 15th consecutive year, the MDC, hosted the annual Source to Sea Clean-Up held at the Wethersfield Cove on September 28.

The community cleanup of the Connecticut River and its tributaries is a four-state event coordinated by the Connecticut River Watershed Council, a non-profit advocacy organization working to conserve and protect water quality, habitat and recreational access across the entire Connecticut River Watershed.

A record number of volunteers turned out (nearly 100) including MDC staff, environmental organizations, citizens, students, Boy Scouts and DEEP Commissioner Robert Klee. Hundreds of bags of garbage and debris were collected including rusty car parts, tires, bottles, miscellaneous litter and more.

By participating in the cleanup, local organizations, watershed groups, schools and the community are preventing and addressing trash to foster cleaner, more vibrant rivers and a healthier Wethersfield Cove.

About the MDC: The MDC provides water, sewer and household hazardous waste collection services to its member municipalities: Bloomfield, East Hartford, Hartford, Newington, Rocky Hill, West Hartford, Wethersfield and Windsor.
