Re: MDC 2020 Rates

Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter is to notify you of the 2020 charges for the Surcharge Outside the Metropolitan District for Capital Improvements which will affect Glastonbury approved by the MDC District Board on February 10, 2020.

Four previously completed capital improvement projects in Glastonbury serve as the basis for calculation of the surcharge; they are the Buckingham Water Pump Station Replacement, Oak St. Transmission Main, Ph II, Neipsic Woods Water Main, and Hemlock Hill Water Main.

The new 2020 monthly charges, by meter size, are indicated on the chart below as well as the 2019 approved charges:

MDC's current methodology allocates costs based upon the percentage of hydraulic capacity of each meter size. MDC's 2019 methodology allocated costs based upon actual consumption using the last full prior year's consumption.

The 2019 Capital Improvement Project surcharge for a residential (5/8") meter was \$3.58 per month; it will decrease to \$1.57 per month. For higher capacity users (4" meter) the 2019 surcharge was \$128.08 per month which will increase to \$469.77 per month in 2020.
