Judy Allen of West Hartford stated that she was impressed with the level of detail in the white paper. She noted two items that stood out to her. First, on page 18: "we typically do not seek a technology and then figure out how to apply it – we look to implement best practices and then find well-suited technologies to support those practices." Second, on page 30: "From a bigger picture perspective, the District's long-term viability and success in excelling at our core water and wastewater business lies squarely on the shoulders of our staff. Infrastructure and technology alone cannot make drinking water or treat wastewater. Continuously attracting topnotch talent, providing outstanding training, developing in-house expertise, ensuring the best tools are available, and developing in-house expertise, ensuring the best tools are available, and developing leadership skills are all critical to mission success. These are the items necessary to implement utility best practices, which will drive technology needs." Lastly, she also stated how appreciative she is of the work done by the entire MDC staff and commended Commissioner Mandyck for her vision for this committee.
