



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

SEWER SEPARATION, WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT & METER PIT INSTALLATION WORK TO BEGIN

(Durham Street - Hartford)

Beginning the **week of July 17th**, the Metropolitan District (MDC) and their contractor, VMS Construction Company, will be starting construction to replace existing watermains, services, install meter pits and make sewer improvements in your neighborhood. Once the new watermain (between Palm and Lyme), meter pit and new water services are installed you will be contacted by MDC Staff to schedule a time for the meter to be relocated from inside your home to its new location. **During the meter relocation process, your water service may be temporarily interrupted for approximately 4-6 hours.** *An MDC Staff member will contact you in advance of the interruption in service.*

The purpose of the meter pit is to provide easier access to the meter and will eliminate the need to enter homes for meter readings or repairs.

In cases where the meter pit installation requires a potential disturbance or need to relocate existing landscaping, fixture or structure, MDC Staff will coordinate with the homeowner to determine best course of action for the meter pit location. Temporary restoration efforts, including backfill and patching of sidewalks will be fully restored to the same or better condition once the entire project has been completed. Please refer to the meter pit photo examples on the reverse side of this notice.

During the project the contractor may temporarily store materials in the "green-belt" portion of the public right of way. Any disturbed areas will be restored to pre-existing conditions upon the completion of work. Work hours will be Monday through Friday, between 7:00am and 5:00pm. The entire water & sewer project will take 2-3 months to complete. Further notifications will be provided throughout the duration of the project.

Schedules are subject to change based on weather or unforeseen construction related activities. All MDC Staff, Contractors and Consultants must be properly identified and present ID upon request.


